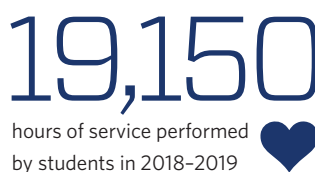
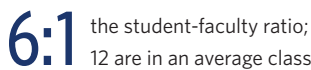
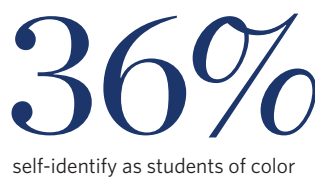
Campus Information

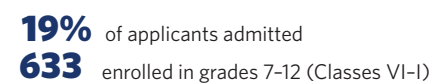

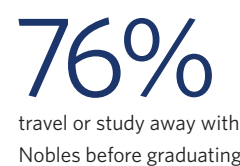
