As we head into our thirteenth summer, we aim to continue building strong relationships with our students while engaging them in a rigorous academic experience. Teaching Assistants are important members of the Achieve team, and they are essential to our students' academic and personal success.

Qualifications:

- Current college student, recent college graduate, graduate student, or new teacher.
- Experience and/or interest in working with middle school students in grades six through eight.
- Strong ability to collaborate and communicate effectively.
- Excellent organizational skills.
- High energy and a sense of humor!

Responsibilities:

- Provide a consistent adult presence all day.
- Support a Master Teacher in English, Math, or Science with teaching and classroom management.
- Serve as an advisor.
- Lead enrichment activities, academic intervention and book clubs.
- Attend all morning and afternoon meetings, and lead several afternoon meetings.
- Chaperone field trips on Fridays.
- Carry out other duties, as assigned by Directors.
