### **NOBLES SUMMER SEMINAR POLICIES & GUIDELINES**

#### PROGRAM COST

- If you enroll before or on June 15, the cost of each course is \$500.
- If you enroll after June 15, the cost of each course is \$600.

# **CANCELLATION POLICY**

Nobles Summer Seminars run based on enrollment numbers.

- If you must drop this course for any reasons, you are eligible for a full refund if your drop request is received on or before June 15.
- You are eligible for a partial (50%) refund if you drop the course on or before July 1.
- After July 1, you are not eligible for a refund.

## REQUEST TO SWITCH CLASSES

Nobles Summer Seminars are designed to be an engaging and intensive four weeks of learning. Given the pace of this program, a student who begins a course after the first class(es) may have a difficult time catching up to their classmates.

- Class Switch Requests will be considered before the start of the program (July 6) and after the first two classes (July 6 & July 8).
- After July 8, no Class Switch Requests will be considered.

### ATTENDANCE POLICY

Nobles Summer Seminars are student-centered and fueled by student engagement, curiosity, and participation. Attendance is crucial to a meaningful experience.

A student must attend a minimum of 9 out of 12 classes (75%) to receive a Certificate of Completion for this program.

#### **HOMEWORK POLICY**

In addition to 3 synchronous classes per week, a teacher may assign 2-3 hours of homework out of class during the week. Intended to advance concepts, solidify learning, and provoke thinking, this outside work deepens the intellectual experience in the virtual classroom. The inability to complete homework will impact both individual and classroom experience.

A student who attends classes but who does not complete 70% of the assigned work may not be eligible to receive a Certificate of Completion for this program.
